Robert R. Dodds, 73, 416 S.
First Ave., Danville, died from
complications of pneumonia at
3:45 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 1, 1998,
at University Hospitals in Iowa
City.

Born July 27, 1924, in Burling-
ton, he was the son of Horace
W. and Florence Hillgartner
Dodds. He married Frances M.
Floyd March
1, 1965, in
Monmouth,
Ill.

ate of Dan-
ville High
School, at-
tended Burl-
ington Junior
College and was a World War
II Army/Air Force veteran.

Mr. Dodds farmed all of his
life and owned and operated
Bob Dodds Insurance in Dan-
ville. He was a preacher at

17½ years and filled in at vari-
ous churches. He was founder
of Mud Creek Chapel Retreat,
Little White Chapel in the
Woods in rural Danville and
