## David E. Weichman

NEWHALL — David E. Weichman, 78, of Newhall, died of cancer Tuesday evening, April 11, 2000, in Hallmar Care Center in Cedar Rapids.

Services with military honors at 10 a.m. Saturday in Cedar Memorial Chapel of Memories. The Rev. William Harnish will officiate. Burial in Cedar Memorial Park Cemetery. Friends may call at Cedar Memorial Funeral Home from 4 to 7:30 p.m. on Friday and at the chapel after 9:30 a.m. On Saturday.

Survivors include his sister-in-law Gladys Weichman of Newhall, two nephews, Steven of Walla Walla, Wash., and Michael of Jefferson City, Mo., and one niece, Janeen Lange of Palmetto, Fla., and several grand nephews and nieces. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother Herbert. David was born in Newhall on Sept. 22, 1921 to Harry and Elizabeth (Meyer) Weichman. He graduated from Newhall High School in 1939 and attended the University of Iowa, receiving his B.A. in 1946 and his J.D. at the College of Law in 1946. He practiced law in Newhall for 52 years.

He was in the Army Air Corps (1942-1945) and a pilot of a B-24 involved in bombing raids over Europe. He retired from the U.S. Air Corps Reserves in 1972 with the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. During his career he was a Field Representative, Iowa Department of Public Safety; Law Clerk, Iowa General Assembly; Newhall City Attorney and Treasurer; Justice of the Peace; State Representative in the Iowa General Assembly; and Judicial Magistrate, Benton County.

David was a member of the Benton County and Iowa State Bar Associations, VFW, and John Ward McGranahan Post 167 of the American Legion. He was active in local, state and national Legion functions serving as State Department Commander in 1965-1966. He served a term as Judicial Advocate and many years on the National Legislative Committee.
