VINTON— Harley Hanson, age 85, died Wednesday, January 2, 2002 at Heritage

Nursing and Rehab Center in Cedar Rapids following a lingering illness.

He was born June 20, 1916, on a farm South of Vinton, the son of Sven and Belle (Mc Elhaney) Hanson. Harley graduated from Lincoln High School in Vinton and served his country in the Navy, as a 2nd class Machinist, Ås Mate stationed in San Diego from 1935 through 1939. On April 30, 1941, he was united in marriage to Ina Mae Wiese at the Little Brown Church in Nashua. The couple farmed south of Vinton until retiring in 1969. They lived in California for three years and returned to Vinton in 1972. Harley was an active member of the First Christian Church in Vinton, where he served as a deacon and elder. He also served as a member of the Benton County Crop Commission, the Benton County Farm Service board, The Benton County Cattle Feeders Association Board and the Benton County Farm Bureau, where he held the offices of trea-

surer and president. In his spare time, Harley loved to fish and enjoyed many family trips to Lake of the Woods, in Minnesota.

He is survived by his wife Ina Mae; son Robert Hanson and wife Beverly of Cedar Rapids; daughter Barbara Franks of Union City, CA; nine grandchildren, Jim Hanson, Becky Barrett, Chris Hanson, Scott Franks, Jon Franks, Randy Krause, Debbie Wood, Mary Mease and Tom Krause; twenty-two great grandchildren; brother, Lewis Hanson and wife Joan of Dana Point, CA; and sister Jan Long and husband Hal of Lake Tahoe, CA

He was preceded in death by his parents, and his half sister, Carol Ecrement.
