Former state legistlator dies

Semor C. Tofte, former Iowa state legislator from Decorah, died Monday, Nov. 21, at his Rochester, Minn. home.

He was 83. A memorial service will be held Friday, Nov. 25, at 1 p.m., at First Lutheran Church in Decorah.

Tofte and his wife, the former Pearl A. Enga, lived in Decorah from 1937 until 1993, at which time they moved to Rochester.

Tofte was involved in a John Decre business in Decorah. After retiring, he served 12 years in the Iowa

State Legislature as a state representative, from 1972 until 1984. He had earlier served on the Decorah City Council for 10 years.

Tofte was a member and past president of First Lutheran Church in Decorah, a past president of the Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Rotary Club and past Exalted Ruler of the Decorah Elks, He was selected as the Decorah Jaycees "Man of the Year" in 1943.
