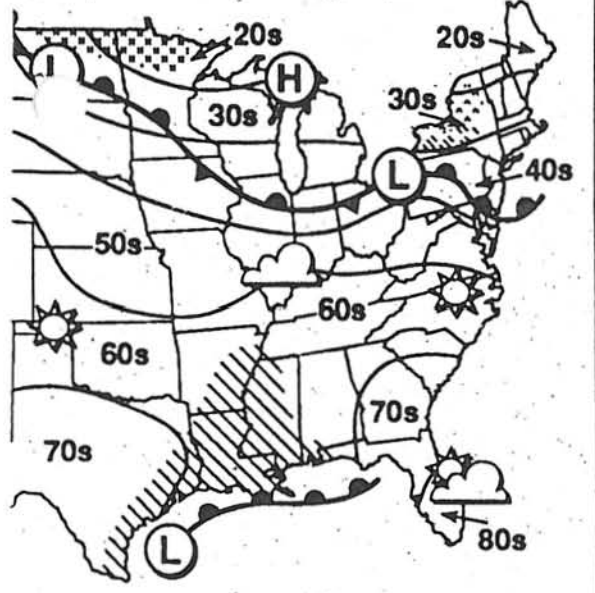

Walter I. Conway, 86, of 214 Clinton St., died early today, Friday, Feb. 21, 1992 at Muscatine General Hospital.

Services will be at 9 a.m., Monday, Feb. 24 at St. Mary's Catholic Church. Organist will be Beverly Weber. Burial will be at St. Mary's Cemetery.



Visitation will be Sunday afternoon at the Riley Funeral Home. A vigil rite will be at 8 p.m.

Mr. Conway was born July 23, 1905 in Muscatine, the son of James P. and Eleanor Susan Schweitzer Conway. He was a life resident of Muscatine. He married Dorothy Genevieve Boland on July 14, 1931 in Muscatine.

He was a life member of St. Mary's Church.

He was elected mayor of Muscatine for three terms and also had served as city councilman for three terms.

He was manager of the Muscatine Railroad Express Agency and later served as State Representative for one term. He also served as chairman of the State Board of Control of State Institutions for two years.

He was the Muscatine Postmaster when he retired.

He is survived by four sons, Jerome W. Conway of Muscatine, Richard M. Conway M.D. of Friendswood, Texas, Thomas E. Conway of Iowa City, and Michael A. Conway of Alaska; one daughter, Kathleen Haller of Arlington Heights, Ill.; 15 grandchildren, five great grandchildren; and one brother, Phillip Conway of Route 4, Muscatine.

He was preceded in death by his wife Dorothy on March 21, 1988, two brothers and one sister.
