Robert Rider, Widely Known Farmer, Dies

Robert E. Rider, 56, Route 3, widely known area farmer, died Saturday evening in Wabasha, Minn. He was vacationing there at Pequot Lakes when he became ill. He had suffered a heart condition the past few years.

Active in the Democratic party for many years, Mr. Rider served in the state House of Representatives during the 61st General Assembly in 1965, serving on agricultural, governmental affairs and public health committees. He was a former chairman of the Marshall County Democratic Committee and served on the committee's board.

Born Near Toledo

He was born Dec. 25, 1921, near Toledo, the son of Clifford and Myrtle Justus Rider. He received his education and spent his early life at Garwin.

He was married to Dorothy Wickersham Oct. 27, 1946, in Marshalltown. He farmed all of his life until ill health forced his retirement two years ago. He had lived in his present home since his marriage.

Surviving are his widow, four children, Patricia (Mrs. Bob) Jordan, Marshalltown, Robert E. Rider Jr., Marshalltown, Ronald Rider, Des Moines; and Nancy (Mrs. Terry) Rhoads, State Center; two sisters, Mary (Mrs. Marvin) Otto, Gladbrook, and Doris (Mrs. Paul) Christianson, Overland Park, Kan., and eight grandchildren. His mother, Mrs. Myrtle Rider, Gladbrook, also survives. His father preceded him in death.

Buyer For Wool Growers

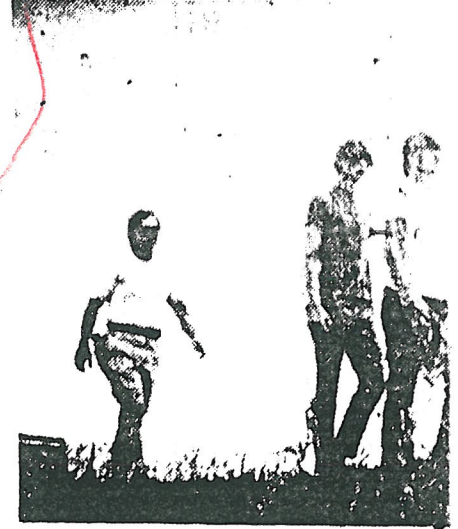
Mr. Rider was a buyer for the Wool Growers Association and a dealer for the Funk's Seed Co.

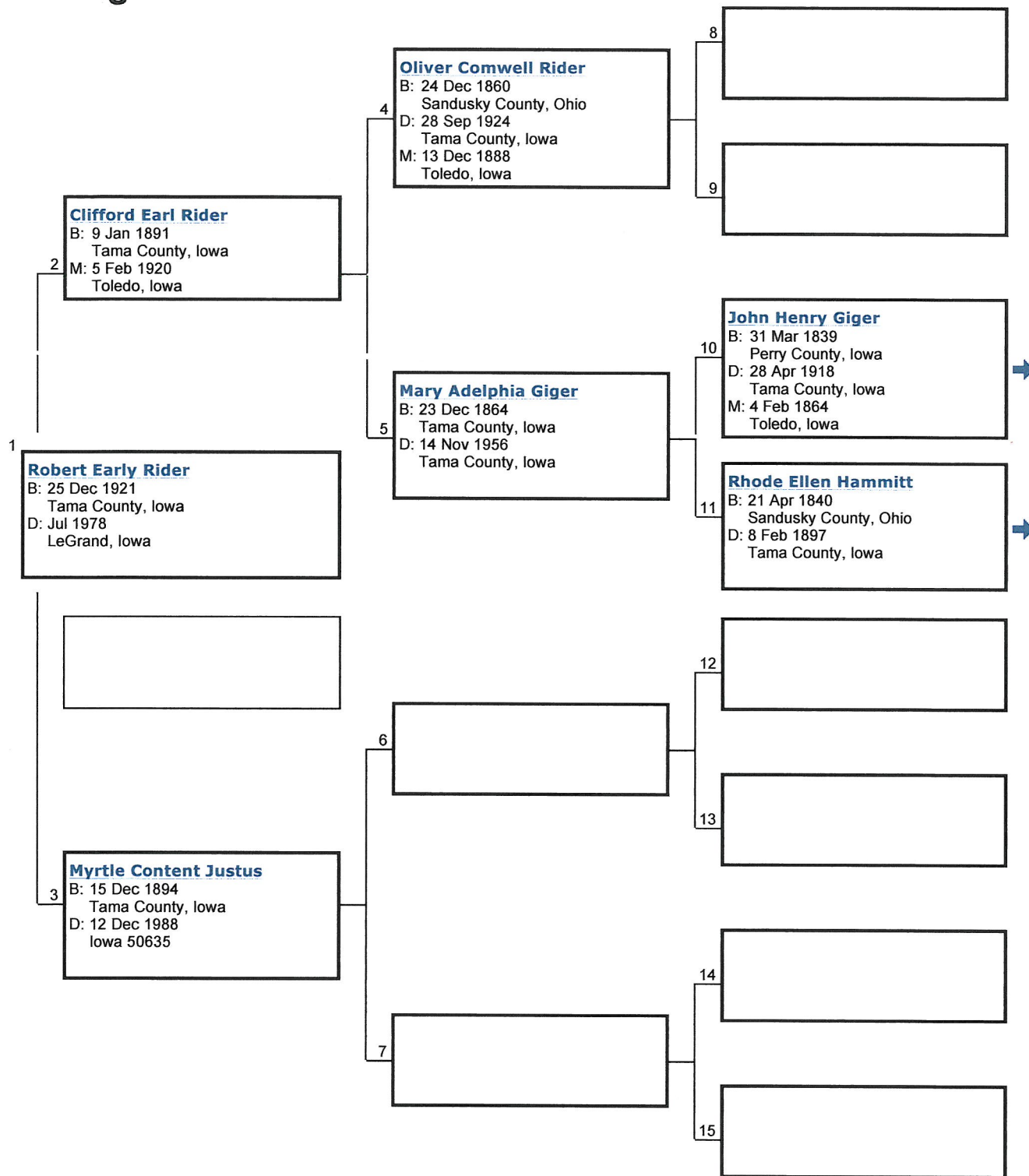
