Former labor leader, state legislator

A memorial service for Carroll Wright, 71, a former area union leader and Iowa state legislator, will be held 7 p.m. Thursday at the Machinists Union Hall, 105 16th Ave., East Moline.

Mr. Wright resided in Dundee, Fla., where he died recently after a brief illness.

He retired in 1975 as president of the Quad-City Federation of Labor AFL-CIO, after more than 30 years in labor activities. He had been a representative of District Lodge 102 of the Machinists union, past secretary-treasurer of UE District 8, president of UE Local 822 and served as a chief steward at the former Herman-Nelson plant.

He had served in the Iowa Legislature as a Democratic state representative during 1964-66.

Mr. Wright was a charter member of the Ridgeview Presbyterian Church, Dayenport; a board member for the United Community Services of Scott County from 1969 to 1971 and had taught a labor course at Black Hawk College, Moline.

He had been a delegate to the Iowa Federation of Labor, to the Iowa and Illinois state councils of Machinists, Iowa vice president of the Quad-City central body, and was a national planning committee member from Iowa of the Grand Lodge Machinists Non-Partisan Political League.

Survivors include his wife, Lurline; a daughter, Mrs. William (Jackie) Kohl Betendorf; a son, Michael, Eldridge; seven grandchildren, a great-grandchild, sisters, Jean Sales and Betty Fuller, both of Canton, Ill.; and a brother, Don, Dayenport.
