**BOONE** — A.V. "Al" Doran, 79,  
1416 First St., died Jan. 17, 1985, at  
Rochester, Minn. He was born Jan.  
22, 1905, in Beaver, the son of Lester  
G. and Clara Chase Doran. He  
married Gwendolyn Williams April  
18, 1936, in Ogden.

Doran practiced law in Boone from  
1931 until 1974. He graduated from  
Drake University Law School with  
honors, and received the Order of the  
Coif. He was a former state senator  
and a member of the Boone School  
board. He was a member of the Lions  
Club, Masonic Lodge Mt. Olive  
Lodge No. 79 AF&AM and Order of  
Eastern Star Magi Chapter 139.

He was preceded in death by his  
wife and a granddaughter.

Survivors include a daughter,
