Howard Sokol, a former state later worked as director of security representative from Osceola before retiring in 1977. He also 2, at his home in Iowa City.

Sokol, age 86, was a former owner of Sibley Concrete Products and Shell Lumber in Sibley. He spent 28 years in the building materials and concrete products

He served as a flight instructor during World War II, and as an American Red Cross Field Director in Germany.

After leaving the construction business, Sokol graduated from the College of Law at the University of Iowa in 1967. He spent two years as an assistant to the dean, and served the lowa Senate as Legislative Counsel. He returned to the University of lowa to serve as vice president of Academic Affairs, and


