Howard Laurel Vincent, was born on December 30, 1910 at what is now Williamson in Lucas County. He was the first born child of Jacob Thomas Vincent and Bertha Willetta Hospelhom Vincent. He passed from this life on August 9, 1988 at his home in Wayne County, after a 16 year battle with cancer. He was 77 years old.

She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary and the Pythian Sisters.





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
