He was a pioneer in Rural Electrification serving on the Charleston Valley Electric Coop for 3 years.

Vincent

Howard Laurel Vincent, was born on December 30, 1910 at what is now Williamson in Lucas County. He was the first born child of Jacob Thomas Vincent and Bertha Willetta Hospelhorn Vincent. He passed from this life on August 9, 1988 at his home in Wayne County, after a 16 year battle with cancer. He was 77-years old.

He was united in marriage to Pauline Barker on November 27, 1936, at the Christian Church building in Confidence. To that union three children were born. He has 13 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Howard Vincent spent his entire life in Wayne and Lucas counties where he worked as a farmer and a building contractor. He served in many ways for the betterment and advancement of the community. For example he was a pioneer in Rural Electrification and served on the board of Chariton Valley Electric Coop for 31 years. He served one term in the Iowa Senate. He was on the board of directors of York College in York, Neb., for 24 years. However, his greatest service was channeled through the Sunnyslope Church of Christ where he was a faithful and active member.

He is survived by his wife, Pauline, and his children: daughter Hazel Elzan and her husband, Roger McMurry, and family of Franklin, Mo.; daughters, Mary Dianne and her husband, Harold Mitchell, and family of York, Neb.; son Jacob Milton and wife, Marilyn, and their children of Harlingen, Tex.; and a foster son, Loyd Hardesty and his wife, Patsy, and children of Woodsboro, Tex. Also his twin sister, Hazel Mendenhall, of Moreno Valley, Calif.; a sister Willetta Stafford, and her husband, Melvin, of Burnsville, Minn.; twin sisters Wyona of Woodburn, who is married to Don Baker and Wyota, who is married to Walter Stark at Rupert, Idaho; and his brother Verne Vincent and wife Irene, of Chariton.

Funeral services were held at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, August 13, 1988 at the Fielding Funeral Home, with Jacob Vincent, Loyd Hardesty, Harold Mitchell and Roger McMurry officiating.
