He was born July 31, 1911, at Wilmette, Ill., the son of Lawrence and Grace Whitehead Rockwell. On June 20, 1939, near Trenton, he married Eunice Monson who survives.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Mt. Pleasant. A retired farmer, he served as a state representative from 1959 to 1963.

Surviving are his wife; two sons, John B. Rockwell Jr., Champlin, Minn., and William H. Rockwell, rural Salem; two daughters, E. Mary Rockwell, Mt. Pleasant, and Mrs. Suzanne Rockwell-Lushin, Randolph, Vt.; a brother, Mathew Rockwell, Chicago, Ill.; four grandchildren.

His parents and a sister, Grace, preceded him in death.

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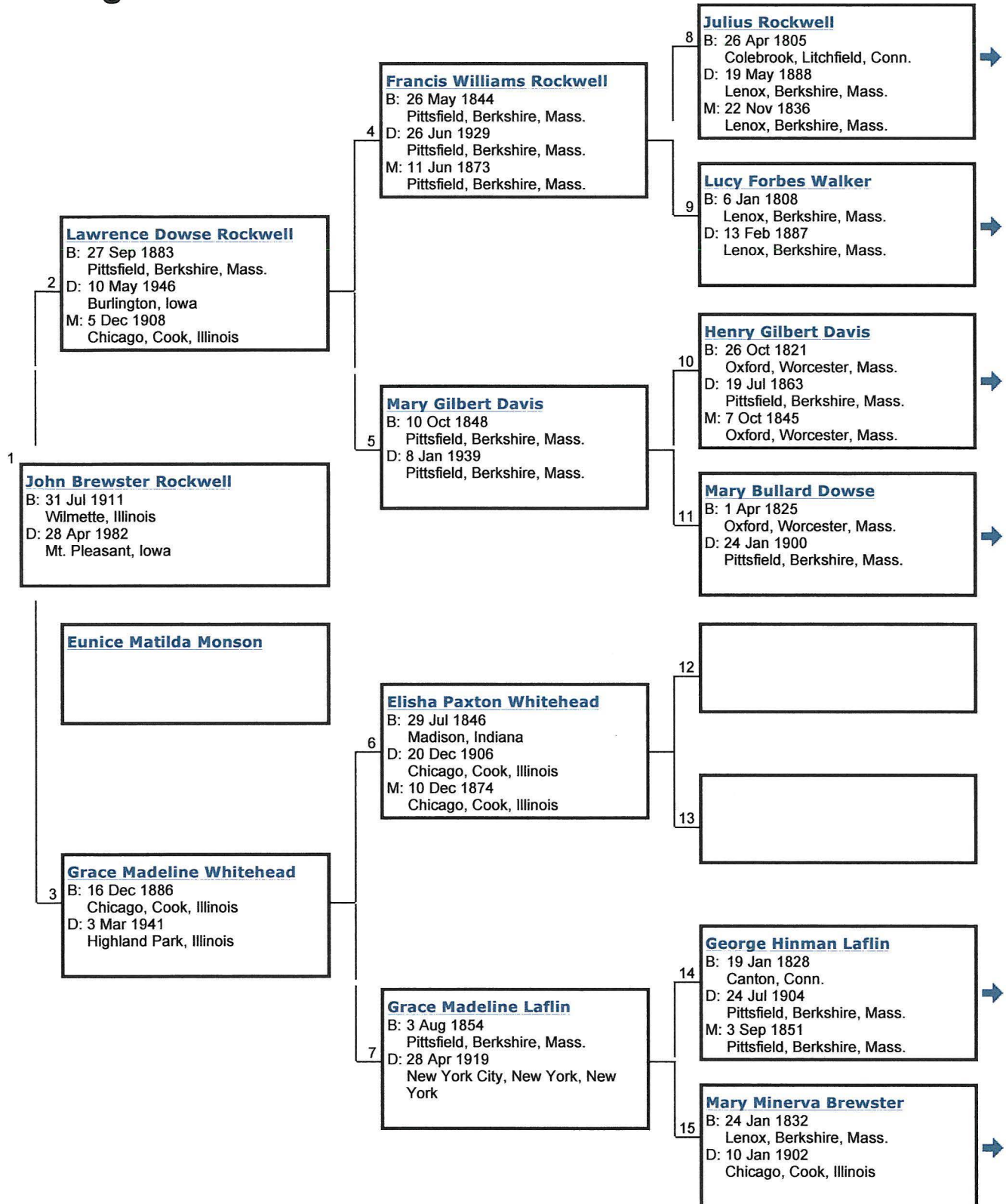
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Pedigree Chart
