FAYETTE — Donald L. Kimball, 72, of Fayette, died Monday morning, April 4, 2005, at his home after a lengthy illness.



Funeral services will be 1:30 p.m. Friday, April 8, at the Jamison-Schmitz Funeral Home in Oelwein, with the Rev. Dan Driscoll officiating. Burial will be in Hazleton Cemetery (Fontana Addition), Hazleton.

Donald L. Kimball was born Feb. 15, 1933 at Fairbank, the son of Donald Keith and Katherine (Finch)

Kimball. He graduated from Stanley High School in 1951 and from Upper Iowa University in Fayette, in 1960. He was a veteran of the Korean Conflict serving in the Army. Don married Mary E. Moore on May 5, 1957 at the Grace United Methodist Church in Oelwein. He was a history teacher at Manchester and Primghar, a former state legislator, an author, and owned and operated the Fayette Leader Newspaper. Don was a member of the Fayette American Legion Post No. 339 at Fayette, and was a longtime Fayette resident.

Don is survived by his wife, Mary Kimball of Fayette; three daughters, Dayna (Scott) Baker of Maynard, Angie (Thomas) Joseph of Heidelberg, Germany, and Kathy (Kevin) Thomas of Fayette; eight grandchildren, Caleb Baker, Brandon Thomas, Jared Baker, Brent Thomas, Allyssa Joseph, Kaitlin Thomas, Natalie Joseph and Samuel Thomas; his parents, Katherine and Tom Berger of Oelwein; one brother, Bob Kimball of Evergreen, Colo.; and four sisters, Marlene (Kenny) Moeller of Solon, Connie Destival of Panama City, Fla., Shirley (Bob) Jones of Des Moines, and Mary (Larry) Hiemes of Arlington.

He was preceded in death by his father, Donald Keith Kimball, and two brothers, Jack Kimball and Tommy Berger.
