Carl H. Hensley, the son of William and Minnie Dettman Hensley, was born February 15, 1897 in Audubon County, Iowa and died February 15, 1985 at the Exira Care Center in Exira at the age of 88 years.

He received his education in the Audubon County Schools and first attended the Greeley Center Methodist Church. He served in the U.S. Army during World War I.

On March 3, 1919 he married Edith Hansen and they farmed in Greeley Township. She died November 15, 1943. He remained on the farm with his daughter and son-in-law, Bernice and Ronald St. John for 25 years until his marriage to Evlyn Hamlin Miller on December 23, 1969. They lived in Braddyville, Iowa until 1972 when they moved to Exira. After one month in the hospital he became a resident of the Exira Care Center two weeks before his death. He was a member of the Exira Christian Church.

He served in the lowa Legislature in the 1957-58 and 1961-62 sessions, was very active in soil conservation and was an early AAA committeeman, was president of the REA Board for a number of years, and was active in the Braddyville Lions Club.
