Thompson became ill at the Amanas while returning home from a U of I football game last Saturday. He was taken to Iowa City for emergency surgery.

He is survived by his wife, Eva; a son, Greg; and a daughter, Rae Jensen, both of Delmar, Ia.; two sisters, Annabelle Foard of Virginia and Clara Mae McConnell of Mediapolis; two step-daughters, Elinor Olsen and Sandy Moore; three grand-

children and five step grand-children

Thompson is a former state legislator and county attorney. He and King Batschelet were partners in the Batschelet and Thompson law firm for 30 years.

Donald K. Hicks, who has been residing the past several months with his son, John Hicks, at Knox Knolls Presbyterian camp, Guthrie Center, died Monday, Oct. 10, at Mercy Hospital in Des Moines, having suffered a heart attack Saturday.
