A retired Oelwein dentist and former state legislator, Dr. John C. Davis, died early Sunday morning at the Oelwein hospital. Dr. Davis was 94.

Funeral services will be held at the Hintz Funeral home Wednesday, June 6, at 1:30 p.m. with the Rev. Richard B. Emery of Christ United Presbyterian church officiating. Burial will be in Woodlawn cemetery.

Friends may call at the Hintz Funeral Home after 4 p.m. today (Monday).

Dr. Davis is survived by a daughter, Eleanor Jane, Mrs. Robert Stonebraker, Cedar Rapids; and one son, Dr. Thomas J. Davis, Marion. Seven grandchildren, one great grandchild and twin nieces also survive.

Dr. Davis was born July 15, 1878 in Mount Vernon, Iowa, the son of Thomas F. and Martha Keppler Davis. He had lived in Oelwein since 1899 when he began his dentistry practice here.

He was a member of the Elks, Rotary, Chamber of Commerce, Oelwein chapter No. 45, Order of Eastern Star, 32nd degree Mason and a member of the Consistory, El Kahir Temple of the Shrine. He was a past president and honorary board member of Oelwein Federal Savings and Loan.

Dr. Davis had been a member of the Iowa State Dental Association, American Dental Association and the Dubuque district Dental Association.

From 1945 to 1951 Dr. Davis served as a member of the Iowa State Legislature. He was a member of the Pioneer Club of State Legislators.
