Last Rites For Elmer Pieper Were Saturday

Elmer F. Pieper, 77, former Waukon attorney and state representative from Allamakee county, died at the Veterans Hospital in Knoxville Tuesday, March 10, following a long illness.

Mr. Pieper was born on a farm in Ludlow township, Allamakee county, December 24, 1886. He graduated from high school in Waukon in 1907, from The State University of Iowa in Iowa City with the degree of bachelor of arts in 1911 and from the college of law at SU in 1915.

He was superintendent of schools at Lineville from 1911 to 1913, and was admitted to

the practice of law in 1915 and that year opened a law office in Waukon. During World War I he was at Camp Dodge for 13 months. He was Allamakee county attorney for eight years and was elected to the state legislature in 1939. He served for six terms.

Mr. Pieper is survived by three sons: Robert of Sioux Falls, S. D.; Roger of Des Moines and Richard of Los Angeles, Calif., and four grandchildren. Four sisters: Mrs. Jesse Beer, Coralville; Mrs. Jack Boyles of Fort Dodge; Mrs. Cecil Munson, Washington, D. C. and Mrs. L. Mickelsen of Belcourt, N. D. also survive.

Funeral services were held Saturday, March 14, from Bakke and Hanson funeral home with the Rev. D. D. Kauffman officiating. Burial was in Oakland Cemetery. Pallbearers were John Shafer, Lynn Morrow, Sherman Hart, Arthur H. Jacobson, Charles Palmer and G. B. Richter.


