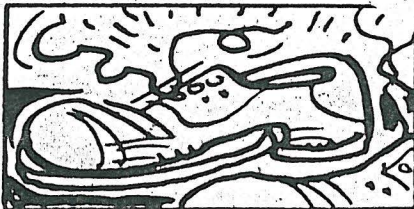
HARLAN LEROY POTE

Services for Harlan Leroy Pote, 87, Lawrence, Ks., were held November 3 in Colorado Springs, Co. Mr. Pote died October 31, 1988 at a Lawrence, Ks. hospital.

He was born July 30, 1901 at Bridgewater, Iowa, the son of Guy Jacob and May Boyd Pote. He grew up in Iowa and received a pharmacy degree from Des Moines School of Pharmacy. He lived in Lawrence four years.

Mr. Pote was a member of First United Methodist Church, a Masonic lodge and White Shrine, all at Colorado Springs. He was also a member of Moila Shrine at St. Joseph, Mo.

He was married to Sara Ione Steward June 7, 1922 at Fontanelle, Iowa. She died in August 1979.

Betty P. Bowman, Lawrence and Pat S. Levy of Coffeyville; a son Jerry R. Pote, Stafford, Tx.; a sister Verda Perkins, El Toro, Ca.; a brother Jack Pote, Colorado Springs; six grandchildren; and a great grandchild.

BENJAMIN EDWARD HOWES

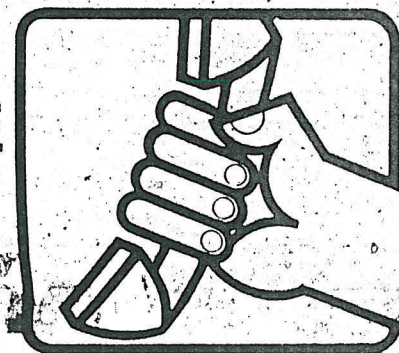
