OBITUARY

Edwin August Getscher was
 born May 16, 1913 at Logan,
 Ia. to Philip John Getscher and
 Gusta Matilda Kirch Getscher.
 He died at the Sidney Health
 Care Center Dec. 13, 1993.

Edwin started attending the
 Methodist church when he was
 about 6 years old and continued
 through the rest of his life and
 was a faithful member of the
 Hamburg United Methodist
 Church.

Edwin married Ione Earhart
 Sept. 5, 1936. To this union
 two sons were born; Edwin
 Clarke Getscher of Omaha, Ne.
 and Marshall Craig Getscher of
 Hamburg.

He graduated from Nebraska
 University Law school in
 1939.

He was president of Delta
 Theta Phi legal fraternity, and
 he passed the bar in 1939.

Edwin belonged to the
 Fremont County Bar
 Association, Southwest Iowa
 Bar Association, Iowa State
 Bar Association, Nebraska
 State Bar Association and the
 American Bar Association.

Edwin was elected State
 Representative from Fremont
 County in 1942. Although
 senators and representatives
 were automatically deferred
 from service, Edwin chose to
 enlist in the Navy. He skip-
 pered a ship and sailed as far as
 the Azores in the Atlantic.
 Most of his duty was in the
 Pacific. He was trained as a
 beachmaster and was due to go
 into Japan before the first wave
 to direct the landing when the
 first atom bomb was dropped
 on Hiroshima.

Edwin knew Bull Halsey
 (Fleet Admiral). Edwin was
 the attorney for the whole
 Pacific fleet for a short time.

He served as Fremont
 County Attorney from 1955-
 1960. He was president of
 Kiwanis and eventually held
 the post of Lt. Governor. He
 was also parade Marshal of
 Popcorn Day. Edwin was a
 member of many other organi-
 zations including the Elks,
 Eagles, VFW, American
 Legion, Odd-Fellows, and fifty
 years as a Mason.

He was preceded in death by
 his father and mother.

Edwin is survived by his
 wife; two sons; two brothers,
 Phillip E. Getscher of Las
 Vegas, Nv. and Frank K.
 Getscher of Ceresco, Ne. and
 other relatives and friends.
