A. Claire Dewey Dies Today

A. Claire Dewey, 76, former Iowa State Senator and Washington business man, died this morning, July 9, 1963, in Mercy Hospital at Iowa City. His home was at 113 South Marion Avenue here, and his death followed an illness of two years. The funeral will be Thursday at 2 p.m. in the Jones Funeral Home with the Rev. Harold DeVries in charge. Burial will be in Elm Grove Cemetery.

Mr. Dewey was born Sept. 1, 1886 in Washington, a son of Seneca Beach and Elnora Smouse Dewey. He attended public schools here, the Washington Academy, and graduated from Drake University.

He was married Oct. 17, 1905 to Pearle Fox.

Mr. Dewey had served two terms in the Iowa Senate; was vice president of the Will H. Dilg Conservation League of Iowa; a board member of the National Parks Association; and for many years served on the board of the Iowa

Taxpayers Association.

He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, the Masonic Lodge No. 26 A. F. and A. M., and Cyrus Chapter No. 13, Royal Arch Masons.

Mr. Dewey was a partner for many years in the Fox-Dewey Shoe Store here.

He is survived by his wife.

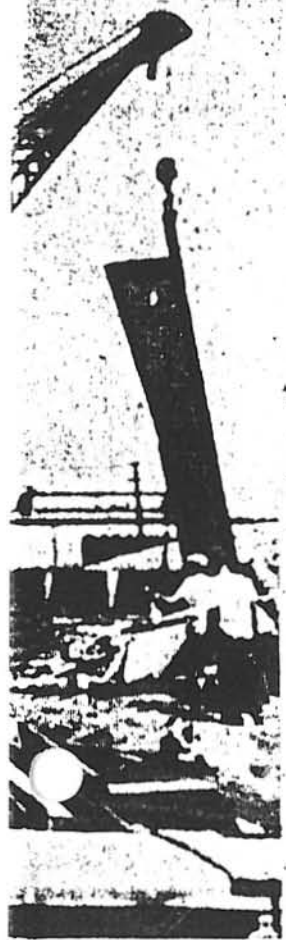
