- In 1932 he started farming and raising game birds and hunting dogs in Delaware County, Iowa as well as a general agent for Iowa Farm Mutual Insurance Company
- He was especially interested in raising quail and pheasants for restocking and shooting reserves. He also raised Cocker Spaniel dogs for shows and hunters
- Military service - World War I - a volunteer for the American Red Cross Ambulance Corps.

## Hugh Washington Parker, 91

Hugh Washington Parker, 91, of Dubuque, died Sunday, March 7, 1993, at Heritage Manor, Dubuque, after a short illness.

The body was cremated. Burial was made in the Greeley Cemetery. A private memorial service will be held at a later date.

He was born at Greeley on Sept. 3, 1901, the son of Arthur J. and Nannie (Sawyer) Parker. He graduated from Greeley High School and attended Upper Iowa College and Rutgers University.

During World War I he was a member of the volunteer American Red Cross Ambulance Corps.

On Jan. 2, 1926, he was married to Doris Christler in Chicago, Ill.

In the 1940's, he was a member of the Iowa House of Representatives. For the last 30 years of his life, he was a Wisconsin antique dealer. He also had been a farmer and insurance agent, raised quail and pheasants for hunting reserves, and raised hunting dogs.

Survivors include his wife and several cousins.

Fawcett's Funeral Home, Winthrop, was in charge of arrangements.

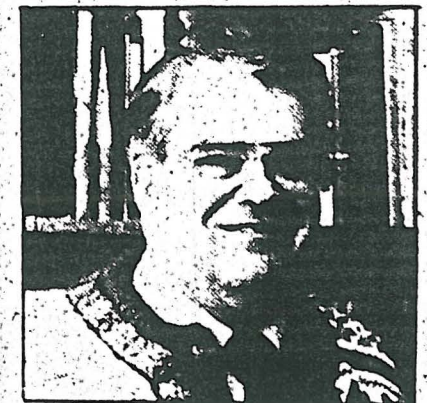
