Elmer Lichty Dies; Was Orange Pioneer

Former State Rep. Elmer M. Lichty, of 256 Hammond Ave., died at 7 p. m. Tuesday at the Woodlawn Convalescent home of complications of advanced age. He was 93.

Mr. Lichty, who had been a patient at the home for the past two months, represented Black Hawk county in the state legislature from 1922 to 1936.

He was born Feb. 2, 1867, in Orange Township, to Hiram and Sarah



Lichty. He married Emma Miller in Summer set, Pa., in 1888. Mrs. Lichty died in 1921, and he married Clara Miller in 1922 in Waterloo.

He spent most of his life farming in the Orange township area, and had been a resident of Waterloo for the past 38 years. A member of the Church of the Brethren, he was treasurer of the South Waterloo Church of the Brethren for 30 years and was on the building committee in 1913.

He also was a member of the original Orange Township school board in 1916.

HE ATTENDED the Orange Township schools and Waterloo Business College. He was a member of the Optimist Club.

Mr. Lichty was survived by his wife, also a resident of the Woodlawn home; three sons, C. M. Lichty, Rt. 1; Ed Lichty, 60 Hammond Ave., and Parker Lichty, 420 Sheridan Rd.; three daughters, Mrs. Alice Klepinger, Neosho, Mo.; Mrs. Ruth Steouffer, Oak Park, Ill., and Mrs.

Dortha Parris, Rt. 1; one brother, Art Lichty, La Verne, Calif.; three sisters, Mrs. W. O. Tannreuther, Rt. 1; Mrs. Grace Zuck, Allen Convalescent home, and Mrs. Homer Frantz, Long Beach, Calif. Also surviving are 12 grandchildren and 29 great grandchildren.

Mr. Lichty was preceded in death by an infant daughter and one brother.

FUNERAL services will be at 1:30 p. m. Thursday at the Waterloo Church of the Brethren, with the Rev. Walter E. Bucher, pastor, officiating. Burial will be in the Orange Township cemetery.

The casket will be taken from the Kearns-Dykeman funeral chapel to the church at 11:30 a. m. Thursday. The casket will not be opened after the service. Friends who wish may contribute to the church building fund.
