David R. McCreery, 78, Alburnett, state representative from Linn county from 1929 to 1933, died Tuesday afternoon in a Cedar Rapids nursing home, where he had been a patient for several weeks.

A prominent Republican, he also served on the Iowa Board of Control from 1939 to 1947. He retired from his farm and moved into Alburnett in 1952.

He is survived by his wife, the former Letitia Quaas.

A sewer rental ordinance was presented by special Counsel Clinton H. Moyer to the Marion city council Monday evening for its consideration.

The ordinance as presented, called for a sewer rental fee equal to 50 per cent of the bi-monthly water bill to be paid by all residents of the city who use city water. The council, after discussion which lasted over an hour, took no action on the matter.

David R. McCreery Rites to be Friday

David R. McCreery, life long Linn County resident, passed away at 12:30 p.m., Tuesday in Cedar Rapids. Born Feb. 14, 1881 near Alburnett, he was the son of David and Margaret Mathes McCreery. He was married to Letitia Quass Feb. 28, 1906 in Alburnett. Mr. McCreery was a member of the EUB church in Alburnett. He served on the 43-44-45 General Assemblies as a Linn County representative. Between 1939 and 1945 he was a member of the Board of Control for State Institutions. He retired in 1952. He lived his entire life in the Alburnett vicinity.

Survivors are his wife Letitia and nieces and nephews.

Services will be in the Murdoch Funeral Home in Marion, Friday 1:30 p.m. with Rev. Robert Day of the Alburnett EUB in charge. Friends may call at the chapel after 7 p.m. Thursday. Interment will be in Linwood Cemetery.

Rural PTA Establishes Memorial

The ordinance would raise about \$40,000 a year inasmuch as water department receipts were in the vicinity of \$80,000 last year.

Sewer rental is being considered as one of the methods by which Marion will pay its share of the joint Marion-Cedar Rapids sewer project, which calls for construction of a sewage disposal plant on the Cedar River and a line running from Marion to the plant.

Marion has obligated itself to pay about \$700,000 toward construction costs of the system. There are three methods of financing available to Marion—special assessment bonds, general obligation bonds and sewer rental.

Moyer indicated that he presented the ordinance now because the city already has had to pay engineering fees and similar expenses. The attorney said that revenue from this ordinance could be used in this manner.

A court case is presently pending concerning the agreement between the two cities. This "friendly" law suit seeks to determine whether there is statutory authority for such an agreement. It is expected that the case will be carried to the state supreme court in the near future.

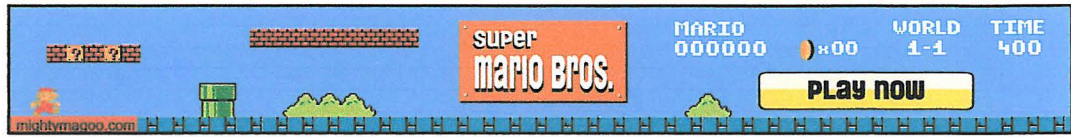

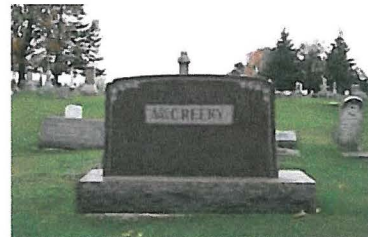
