Well-known lawyer dies

William P. Sheridan, 80, formerly of 1228 Grand Ave., died at Keokuk Area Hospital East following an extended illness. Recently he had been living at the Keokuk Convalescent Center. Mr. Sheridan was a prominent Keokuk lawyer and served for 20 years as U.S. attorney for the southern district of Iowa.i

He was born May 10, 1895 in Bancroft, the son of Nicholas Edward and Ellen Rakow Sheridan. He attended St. Mary's College in Kansas and later graduated from the University of Iowa. He served as an aviator during World War I.

Mr. Sheridan married Lucile Becker in Minneapolis, Minn. He began practicing law in Keokuk in the early 1920s and retired in 1973.

He was a member of St. Francis deSales Catholic Church and an honorary life member of the Knights of Columbus. He was also a member of the Keokuk Country Club Board Chairman Ken

and the Lee County and American-Bar Assns. He was a 50-year member of Elks, the American Legion and the Iowa Bar Assn.

In addition, he served for many years on the Keokuk Bridge Commission.

Mr. Sheridan is survived by a daughter, Ann Sheridan, now serving with the U.S. Foreign Service in the American embassy in Lo don, England; and a sister, Winifred Deitering of Bancroft.

He was preceded in death by his wife on-Dec. 17, 1973.
