Farm business talks scheduled March 8

A special meeting with farm families on the practical problems of farm family contribution arrangements will be held Tuesday, March 8, in Cedar Rapids. The meeting will be from 1 to 4 p.m. in the Grant Wood Area Education Building (across from Hawkeye Downs) and is sponsored by the Extension Service of Iowa State University.

Eldon Olsen, Area Farm Management specialist, says farmers have always encountered some problems in the orderly transition of the farm business from one generation to the next. In recent years the competitive climate of agriculture has increased the need for top farm management skills, multiplied the capital requirements of the farm operation and tripled the dollar value of farm real estate. These changes have increased pressure on young men attempting to enter the farming field and have made planning and selection of farm business organization very meaningful in today's farm transition.

At this meeting a panel of farmers of the area will be chaired by Ken Muller, County Extension Director, Cedar County. They will explain details of their approach to the solution to some of these problems. Advantages and disadvantages that might be encountered in the formation of corporations, partnerships and other

contribution agreements will be aired. Olsen says the discussion will deal with a variety of questions. Should we incorporate? What are some good arrangements for father-son contribution agreements? What are tax and other advantages of one system over another? How do you plan for property transfers in the light of the new estate laws? Questions from the floor will be given priority.

Participating in the discussion will be Scott Boggus, Attorney, and Elmer Deatsch, CPA, both of Cedar Rapids, and ISU farm management specialists Everett Stoneberg of Ames and Olsen.

The public is invited to attend this meeting March 8 and a special invitation is extended to farm wives. A large crowd is expected due to the timeliness of subject material.

Dairymen to meet in Johnson County

Dr. Fred Foreman, Dairy Professor at Iowa State University, will be meeting with Washington, Johnson and Iowa county dairymen Thursday, March 10 on the Johnson County Fairgrounds in Montgomery Hall south of Iowa City at 1:15 p.m., reports Jim Frier, County Extension Director.

A number of dairymen in the Cedar Rapids Extension Area are currently participating in a dairy correspondence course. Dr. Foreman will discuss questions of those enrolled as well as questions of any other dairymen who would like to attend.

Check on arson in Des Moines fires

DES MOINES (UPI) — Fire officials today investigated the possibility of arson in four early morning apartment house fires that occurred during a three-hour period in various parts of the city.

Authorities said Ida Pace, 78, suffered facial and hand burns in the last and most serious fire at her east side eight-unit apartment building. She was being treated at Iowa Methodist Medical Center. Five other persons were treated for injuries. The blaze reportedly caused \$10,000 damage to the building.

The first blaze, reported at 1:40 a.m., occurred in a new apartment building, but no injuries or damage were reported. Twelve minutes later a fire was reported in a 12-unit structure 25 blocks away on the southeast side. Authorities reported some damage but no injuries.

economics and director of Old Capitol. From 1862 to 1863 the room housed the entire history department. Later the room was combined with an adjacent room and monthly meetings of the department heads of the College of Liberal Arts were held there as well as frequent meetings of the State Board of Regents. At one time the room headquartered the U of I Alumni Association.

When the decision was made to restore the room to the period when it served as a territorial library, the job of identifying original books was made easier by the practice of early librarians to write "Iowa State Library" at the bottom of the 30th page of each book.

Many of the books were found in the U of I Main Library, Law Library, the State Historical Society of Iowa Library and the State Library in Des Moines.

Some of the books required more restoration than others, according to Leeta Berry, U of I librarian in charge of book restoration. "We even received some books that had been stored in a barn. The smell was awful."

Two catalogues published in 1839 and 1845 listing all of the titles in the library also provided aid in locating original books.

If legends are to be believed, Ada North, state librarian from 1871-1878, recounted one that sheds some light on the accessibility of the books. "For several years the sole guardian of the library was the key to the door of the room containing it, which was generally left, conveniently near, for the unrestricted use of any person desiring access of the books."

Towards the end of the 19th century Parvin wrote State Librarian Johnson Brigham a letter. In it he compared the 1839 catalogue, which he wrote, to the catalogues of 1845 and 1872. According to Parvin they, "Reveal some facts not so pleasant or creditable to your early predecessors or the territories and state. Many of the volumes found in the catalogue of 1839 are not catalogued in that of 1845 or 1872, showing that there were some book thieves in those days as well as in later years."

have yet to be determined, since the National Bureau of Standards requires such information to be based on readings from collector panels arranged perpendicular to the sun's rays. The collector at North Liberty is built at a fixed inclination of 60 degrees to the ground.

Spencer says the division of energy engineering plans to mount a collector on a movable turret atop the roof of I Engineering Building during the next few weeks. The panel will track the sun across the sky, keeping its surface perpendicular to the sun's rays.

Spencer says the cost of his collector, which he estimates at about \$10 a square foot plus installation, may still seem a bit high for some homeowners.

But he's convinced at least one homeowner of the value of solar energy heating systems. Jack Carfrae says he plans to design and build a collector this summer to heat his home using solar-warmed rocks and warm air.

Rescuers searching for trapped miners

TOWER CITY, Pa. (UPI) — Eighteen rescue workers, searching for nine men believed trapped in an eastern Pennsylvania hard coal mine, broke into the main gangway leading into the mine early today but they found their way blocked by four or five feet of water.

The men were trapped in the Porter tunnel of the Kocher Coal Co., Tuesday when tons of water swept through the mine.

John B. Shutack, district manager of the Federal Mines Enforcement Safety Administration, said the workers were unable to proceed because a pile of timbers, coal and other debris had backed up the water.


Shutack said a team of explosive experts would go into the mine and blow up the debris that was preventing access to the heart of the mine.

"We're going to blast it out," Shutack said. "We're going to send some highly qualified experts into the mine to blast it out." He said the closest rescue workers were able to get to the area where the men were believed to be located was 450 feet.

He said the experts hoped to blast through the logjam in a few hours.

Shutack said "time is in our favor because there is plenty of fresh air and no buildup of noxious gases."
