Dr. E. J. Cole Dead At 101

WOODBINE-Dr. E. J. Cole, 101, one of the oldest citizens in Harrison County, died Wednesday at a Council Bluffs hospital.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at Heft Funeral Home here. The Rev. J. E. McClellan will officiate. Burial will be at Woodbine Cemetery.

A lifetime resident of Woodbine, he was born on a farm there January 24, 1865. He practiced medicine in the area for 55 years, retiring in 1944.

In addition to his medical practice, Dr. Cole served as president of the First National Bank for over 25 years, having begun in 1918.

He was also state representative for Harrison County three terms between 1922-28.

Dr. Cole was graduated from Rush Medical College in Chicago in 1889 and previously attended Iowa State University. His father was a pioneer doctor
