Mr. Sass was born April 19, 1888, in Sloux City. He attended Sloux City elementary schools and was graduated from Sloux City High School. He was graduated from Morningside College in 1915 with a B.A. degree and from the University of Chicago Law School in 1919 with a juris doctor degree.

He married Delberta Edgington Dec. 28, 1929, in Sloux City. She died Feb. 20, 1954, in Sloux City. He was a justice of the peace for eight years. and served a session in the Iowa Legislature beginning in 1929. He practiced law in Sloux City until




