Dr. F. A. Hines Dies Here Sunday at 74

Dr. F. A. Hines, 74, retired
... Creston veterinarian, died at the
... Greater Community hospital here
... at 5 p. m. Sunday. His death fol-
... lowed a 16-month illness.

Funeral services will be held at

... home at 2 p. m. Wednesday. Dr.
... A. P. Keast, pastor of the First
... Methodist church, will officiate.
... Burial will be in the Orient ce-
... metery. Casket bearers will be

... Posten and Charlie Walters. Ma-

... be at the funeral home from 7:30

F. A. Hines was born near
... Macksburg, Dec. 5, 1890. He was
... the son of Charles and Alice E.
... Osborn Hines. He graduated
... from the Orient schools and was
... married at Orient, Aug. 28, 1901,
... to Maude McCracken, who surviv-
... es him.

He attended the Kansas City
... College of Veterinary Medicine,
... graduating in 1913. He establis-
... hed his practice at Gravity, Ia.
... where he remained for 28 years
... before moving to Creston in 1941.
... He was the mayor of Gravity for
... eight years and also served for
... several years on the Gravity
... town council.

Dr. Hines was a member of the
... Methodist church. He also was a
... member of Sunlight Masonic
... lodge, No. 459, at Gravity, and
... the Modern Woodman lodge.

Dr. Hines was a great fancier
... of fine horses, having owned and
... trained many well-known high
... school horses which he personally
... had shown in many fairs and
... horse shows in southwest Iowa
... and in surrounding states.

He is survived by his widow;
... two brothers, Walter Hines and
... Clifford Hines, both of Creston; a
... sister, Mrs. Nellie Hawkins of
... Washington, D. C.; six nieces
... and a nephew. Two children pre-
... ceded him in death.

Adenauer In

No Startling Results Expected From His Trip

... BONN, Germany — (NEA)
... West German leaders expect
... startling results from Gene-
... Konrad Adenauer's projected
... to Moscow in late August or
... tember.

Now that they have had an-
... other look at the Geneva Big 6
... conference they seem convin-
... ced that the acid test of Presi-
... Eisenhower's friendly meet-
... with the Russians will come in
... October.

It is then that the Foreign
... Ministers of the U. S., Britain,
... France and Russia will meet
... to discuss German unity and Eu-
... ropean security.

Despite strong Soviet pres-
... sure the leaders of the Bonn Fed-
... eral Republic are determined:

1. To stand loyally by the West
... European Union and NATO.
2. Avoid any negotiations with
... the East German Communist
... "government."

Both points were emphasized
... with some vigor by Heinrich
... Bretnano, West German Foreign
... Minister, in an exclusive in-
... terview with NEA Service.
... "With West Germany out of
... NATO the Russians would have
... no interest in going to Geneva
... October," von Bretnano said.

What about Moscow's demand
... that West Germans sit down
... at the same table with the Kru-
... schchev's East German puppets?

Von Bretnano: "This does not
... even come into consideration."
... Bonn's 51-year-old Foreign Min-
... ister is widely regarded as one
... of the staunchest pro-American
... and pro-Western leaders in
