LIEBERKNECHT RITES MONDAY

LETTS--Ernst Wright Lieberknecht, 90, Letts, died Friday morning, Mar. 29, at Wapello Nursing Home where he had lived about two years.

He was born Sept. 25, 1883, at Letts, the son of Henry and Salome Wiederrecht Lieberknecht. He married Gertrude Hafner Oct. 30, 1911, at Cranston. A farmer and lifetime resident of Letts community, he was a member of United Methodist church, for many years a director and past president of Eastern Iowa Light and Power Cooperative, member of Louisa county ASC board, Cornell college trustee, and a former state representative.

Surviving are nieces and nephews, including Byron Hafner, Letts.

Funeral services were held Monday at the Letts United Methodist church, with Rev. Gordon Elrick officiating. Burial was in the Letts cemetery.

WINTER MEMORIAL RITES HELD
