F. S. Finley Dies Suddenly

F. S. Finley, 85, Mt. Pleasant lawyer since 1894, died unexpectedly at his home on East Washington here Tuesday morning. Death was attributed to a heart condition from which he had been suffering in recent months.

His condition appeared to be no worse than usual Tuesday morning. He had arisen and eaten breakfast. Later in the morning, he was stricken suddenly.

Mr. Finley was born at Duncan Falls, Ohio. He entered the practice of law here on July 20, 1894 with J. C. McCoid under the firm name of McCoid and Finley, a partnership that extended over 15 years. Mr. Finley was a well known attorney in southeastern Iowa through the years and gained considerable recognition as a criminal defense lawyer. While he continued active until comparatively recently, he had limited his work because of his age and failing health.

He was the last of three Mt. Pleasant attorneys who had long years of service in Mt. Pleasant and who were in their eighties at the time of death. The other two were J. C. McCoid and R. S. Galer.

Mr. Finley had served for many years as chairman of the Mt. Pleasant public library board. In addition to conducting his law practice, he spent much time in looking after his farm operations.

Mr. Finley is survived by his wife and by a daughter, Mrs. Jean Hallman of New York City.
