Charles A. Quick, 72, of 827 14th Ave. S. died in his home at 7:15 a. m. today after a lingering illness of several years.

Funeral services are arranged for 2 p. m. Wednesday in the Snell funeral home with Dr. L. D. Havighurst of the First Methodist church officiating. Delphic chapter, Knights of Rose-Croix will also conduct services. Burial will be in Springdale cemetery. The body is in the funeral home where friends may call beginning at 7:30 tonight.

Charles A. Quick was born on Sept. 25, 1879, near McCausland in Clinton county, the son of Hamilton and Ida Klitzke Quick. As a child, he came to Clinton with his parents. He attended Clinton public schools. He was a state representative in 1918 and 1919. Prior to this, he served two terms as councilman-at-large in Clinton.

A retired switch engine foreman for the Chicago and North Western railroad, he retired in 1944 after 45 years of continuous service. He was a member of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, the Western Star Lodge 100, A.F. and A. M., the DeMolay consistory and a former member of the Kaaba Shrine. He was baptized in the Methodist faith.

He was married on May 9, 1905 to Emma Johns, who survives him. Other survivors are one daughter, Mrs. Ed (Bernice) Lind of Clinton; one son, Robert C. of Glenview, Ill.; one grandson; one sister, Mrs. Walter Joens of Chicago; one aunt; several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, four brothers, two sisters, and one daughter in infancy.
