They are GOOD! Captain Elerick Passes Away.

Capt. James Elerick was born in Belmont county, Ohio, April 6, 1836, and died at Monrovia, Calif., Aug. 7, 1922, aged 86 years, 2 months and 1 day. He leaves one daughter, Mrs. Geo. Seimon, with whom he made his home since leaving Iowa; and one grandson James E. Seimon, who were with him during his last illness and death. They reside at Hinkley, Calif. His wife, who was Miss Maggie Short, preceded him April 1, 1825.

Capt. Elerick enlisted July 17, 1861, in Co. A, 59th Ill. Vol., and was promoted Captain of Co. A, 69th Ill. Vol., December, 1862. He had six brothers who served in the same war of 1861-65. Capt. Elerick participated in the battles of Pea Ridge, Siege of Corinth, Perryville, Ky., Stone River, Liberty Gap, Chickamauga, Look Out Mountain, Mission Ridge, Rocky Ford, Resaca, Burnt Hickory, Kenesaw, Rough Station, Jonesborough, Franklin, Nashville, and siege of Atl anta. He was discharged Dec. 25,1865, having served 4 years, 5 months. 8 days in the war of the Rebelion.

He was a member of the house of representatives from Van Buren county, in the 19th General Assembly; Senator from Jefferson-Van Buren counties in the 30th, 31st, 32nd and 32nd extra Session. He also served two full terms as Sheriff of Van Buren county. He came to Iowa in 1849 and settled in Douds, Village township, Van Buren county, Iowa, where he made his home until a few years ago, when he went to California and made his home with his daughter. Capt. Elerick will be remembered as one of Van Buren county's most honored and prominent citizens by the older citizens, always true to word, upright in all his dealings and alwave commanding respect of all with whom he met. He lived a useful aud active life. Funeral
