W W HAWK DIED AT DAUGHTERS' HOME LAST NIGHT

A half hour before midnight last night Dr. W. W. Hawk died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. O. H. Witmer of this city.

Mr. Hawk had been in this home since the middle of last May when he returned from a stay in Colorado and California. For a number of years he

had been troubled with asthma and bronchitis. Since coming to Newton Mr. Hawk has been able to be out and although he did not get much better, was often very comfortable.

Sunday night he was taken decidedly worse and suffered a great deal all day yesterday.

Short funeral services will probably be held at the O. H. Witmer home Friday morning at 9 a. m. Then the body will be taken to Colfax, his home, where the funeral services will be held about 2:30 p. m. and the body will be placed beside that of his wife in the family lot.
