A. H. SELLS, LONG ILL, IS CALLED

Former Iowa Senator
Dies at Age of 82 at
Home in West D Street

Abraham H. Sells, for four years state senator from Clark county, Iowa, prominent resident of Ontario for the past 13 years, died at his home, 541 West D street, this morning, at the advanced age of 82 years.

Mr. Sells had been gravely ill for the past two weeks and relatives were summoned to his bedside from the middle west.

Mr. Sells was in the mercantile business for 35 years in Murray, Iowa. He was prominent in all activities of his community, serving in the state senate four years, serving as president of the Murray Commercial club, president of the Murray school board and superintendent of the Methodist Sunday school.

Here for 13 Years

He came to Ontario about 13 years ago, but owing to his advanced age and ill-health was unable to take active part in the activities of the city. As long as his health permitted, Mr. Sells was a faithful attendant at the Methodist church and Sunday school of Ontario, and took keen pleasure in attending meetings of the Grand Army of the Republic of which he was an esteemed member.

When only 17 years old he enlisted in Company I, 130th regiment, Indiana volunteer infantry, on December 16, 1863, and served for two and one-half years, participating in several skirmishes.

Twice Saw Lincoln

While in the service he twice saw and heard Abraham Lincoln, once in the senate chamber and again in Ford's theater, where he was later assassinated.

Surviving Mr. Sells are his wife, Mrs. Alice Finkhouser Sells, two daughters, Mrs. Eva Mary Lichty of Long Beach, and Mrs. Alice Lillian Delahoyde, Ontario, one son, Dr. Frank W. Sells, Osceola, Iowa, one brother, Benjamin Sells, North Manchester, Ind., four grandchildren, Mrs. Alice Sells Graeflinger, Miss Laura Lenora Delahoyde, Alan Hugh Delahoyde, Franklin Wesley Delahoyde and two great-grandchildren, John Sells Graeflinger and Robert Frederick Graeflinger.

After all of the animal heat is out of the body they are taken on to the storage rooms which remain at a tempera- ture of ten degrees below zero or are packed and shipped.

For shipping the poultry is packed in small boxes and then shipped in refrigerator cars, each car holding approximately 20,000 pounds of dressed poultry. When at full capacity, the Salem Produce Company will ship three car loads of dressed poultry a week

One feature of the plant is the feather renovator in which the feathers are sterilized, washed and dried, ready for the downy couch of any- one who wishes to make a feather tick or pillow. The plant is a marvel of efficiency even now after its short run. About 2500 head of poultry are being killed a day. Every- thing is kept neat and clean by a force of men hired only for that work.

A. H. SELLS DIES TUESDAY

Father of Dr. Sells Dies in California — Former Resident of This County — Son Was at Bedside

A message was received in Osceola Wednesday morning conveying the sad news of the death of A. H. Sells at Ontario, California on Tuesday morning. Mr. Sells who spent the greater part of his life in Clarke county is well known both here and at Murray and his passing is the cause of much sorrow.

His son, Dr. F. W. Sells, was at his bedside when the end came, having gone to California last week with Mrs. Sells, on receiving a telegram that he had suffered a paralytic stroke. Particulars in regard to the funeral, and burial were not stated in the mes- sage received by Dr. Stroy at the Osceola hospital, Wednesday morning.

JAMES TRIAL IS IN PROGRESS

Case Of State vs Lawrence James on Charge of Bootlegging Started Tuesday—State Ends Evidence

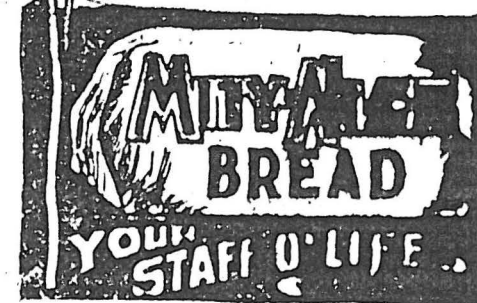
Dr. Clyde Crist and Rev. G. W. Irwin were the officiating ministers.

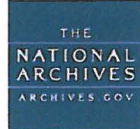



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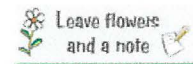
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
