- Lived with parents in Glasgow, Scotland until age 10.
- The family emigrated to Oneida Co. New York in 1850.
- In 1856, they went to Portage City, Wisconsin where they lived for the next several years.
- Moved to Iowa just after marriage and purchased land in Cerro Gordo Co.
- After Civil War, he purchased land in North County in 1866, but sold it in 1870, after moving around and being unsettled at Mason City, Dakota Territory and Forest City.
- Associated with Hon. David Secor in real estate business in 1865
- In Jan 1883 became a member of banking firm of Secor, Law and Plummer.
