DEATH OF M. L. CREW.

Micajah Lemuel Crew was born in Hanover Co. Virginia, on the 13th June, 1835, and died at his home near Salem on Sunday morning March 5, 1905, aged 69 years, 8 mo., 22 da.

He was the son of Walter and Sarah B. Crew in whose family were 14 children, nine girls and five boys.

He came with his parents to Iowa in the year 1849 and in 1850 the family located on a farm about one and one-half miles northwest of Salem, where his parents spent the remainder of their years and which was his home to the time of his death.

In 1859 he married Miriam, daughter of Dr. Samuel Stephenson one of the early settlers of Salem and a leading member of the Cong'l church, and with her he lived happily till her death on Feb. 16, 1886. They were the parents of three children of whom one, Ada, died in childhood and the other two, Mamie and Mattie, are left to mourn the loss of a loving father to whose care and comfort their lives have been devoted.

For a number of years after his marriage Mr. Crew taught school in winter and farmed in summer. For several winters he was principal of public school in Salem. He took much interest in politics, was a ready and logical speaker and in 1881 he was elected to represent the county in the nineteenth General Assembly, and for years after was an earnest advocate of the principles of the republican party in public addresses in the surrounding country till advancing years and the infirmities of age forbade active service in that direction.

The deceased was a man who was held in high regard by all who knew him for his upright character and good judgment and whose place in the community will be hard to fill.

Funeral services were held at the Cong'l church, Tuesday, conducted by the pastor Rev. Robert, assisted by Rev. Hankins of the M. E. church, at which there was a large gathering. Interment was mad—in the Friends cemetery by the side of his wife.
