- Later they moved to Berks County, Pennsylvania where they lived until 1851.
- In 1851 they came to Scott County, Iowa where he purchased a farm near LeClaires, Iowa.
- His wife, Lucy, born 1800, died 1880, also buried in Jackson Cemetery, Princeton Township, Scott County, Iowa.



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## FATAL ACCIDENT.

### The Death of Hon. Robert Scott.

Saturday morning's GAZETTE announced the sudden death of Hon. Robert Scott, of Le Claire, though the cause was not stated. The sad event has cast a gloom throughout the community where the deceased resided. A letter from Dr. Gamble furnishes the following additional information:

Mr. Scott had gone to his home, about 9 a. m. on Friday, and while engaged in repairing the roof on the inside, fell from a height of sixteen feet, and striking on his head on a plank floor, concussion of the brain was produced that must have proved instantly fatal. At what time he fell is not known. He was discovered about noon, the body dead and cold.

Mr. Scott was born in Ireland, in 1801. He came to the United States, in 1804, with his family, and settled with them in Lancaster county, Pa. Afterward they removed to Beaver county, where they resided until 1851, when he came to Scott county, Iowa, and purchased the farm on which he resided until his death, some three miles north-west of Le Claire.

Mr. Scott united with the Methodist Episcopal Church about 1825, and has since been a consistent and exemplary Christian. He represented Scott county in the seventh General Assembly, and was noted for candor, and adherence to principle. In politics, Mr. S. was an old-fashioned abolitionist. He represented his township for several years in the Board of Supervisors, and at his death was one of the township trustees. In every capacity or position he was ever the upright Christian gentleman. He leaves a wife and a large number of children and grand children to mourn his sudden death.

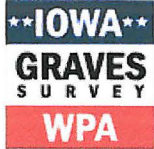
