BILLS SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR

A communication was received from the Governor announcing that on April 25, 2025, the following bills were approved and transmitted to the Secretary of State:

[House File 381](#), an Act relating to statutory corrections which may adjust language to reflect current practices, insert earlier omissions, delete redundancies and inaccuracies, resolve inconsistencies and conflicts, remove ambiguities, and provide for Code editor directives.

[House File 470](#), an Act relating to alcoholic beverages, including license authorizations, bond requirements, and fee determinations, and including effective date and applicability provisions.

[House File 547](#), an Act enacting the respiratory care interstate compact.

[House File 652](#), an Act concerning county and city regulation of real property and the powers granted to a board of adjustment.

[House File 785](#), an Act modifying provisions related to charter school board member requirements.

[House File 844](#), an Act relating to eligibility requirements for financial institutions in which public funds may be deposited.

[Senate File 574](#), an Act relating to retention of fees for public improvement contracts.
