


Employer Sponsored Insurance Coverage, Total Iowa Population (2007-2008)



OTHER INTERESTING IOWA DATA POINTS

• Employer Sponsored Insurance (ESI)


- ✓ **70.1%** of Iowa adults (19-64) are covered by ESI. (7th nationally).
- ✓ Among the nonelderly population (0-64), **67.9%** are covered by ESI (8th highest in US).
- ✓ Among children (0-18), **62.6%** are covered by ESI (9th highest in US).

• Individual Insurance Coverage

- ✓ **7.3%** of Iowa adults are covered by individual policies (12th nationally).
- ✓ **7.1%** of Iowa's nonelderly population (0-64) is covered by individual insurance (10th nationally).
- ✓ **6.5%** of children have individual coverage (6th nationally).

Employer Sponsored Insurance By Family Work Status


- ✓ **75.6%** of lowans in a family with at least 1 full time worker are covered by ESI. (38th nationally).
- ✓ **25.5%** of lowans in a family of part time workers are covered by ESI. (14th nationally).

Medicaid Coverage Rates By Family Work Status

- ✓ **8.3%** of lowans in a family with at least 1 full time worker are covered by Medicaid. (17th nationally).
- ✓ **28.2%** of lowans in a family of part time workers are covered by Medicaid. (31st nationally).
- ✓ Overall, **12.4%** of lowans are covered by Medicaid (17th nationally).

OTHER INTERESTING IOWA DATA POINTS

• Children, Uninsurance and Income

- ✓ **12.6%** of Iowa children (0-18) in families with incomes below 100% of the FPL are uninsured (17th in US).
- ✓ **11.2%** children (0-18), in families with incomes to 133% of FPL are uninsured (12th in US).
- ✓ **4.8%** children (0-18), in families with incomes from 134 - 300% of FPL are uninsured (15th in US).
