





The Class of 2019 – A higher bar







The Road to Reducing the Cost of Education

- *Summer Hawk* Tuition Grants (\$3.5M)
- *4-Year graduation* rates (53.2%)
- *3-Year degree* program
- UI/Kirkwood Regional (**STEM**) Center
- Providing educational opportunities in Des Moines - “*Dome To Dome*”



Some of This Year's Highlights

- Largest and most prepared entering class in UI history
- Highest graduation rates in UI history
 - 4-Year: 53.2%....6-Year: 72%
- Top-notch Graduate/Professional programs
 - 11 programs and specialty areas ranked in the Top 10
- Despite negative Federal trends, research funding growth
 - \$438.5M earned in FY15, up 2% from previous year
- University of Iowa Graduates Serving Iowa:
 - 80% Dentists
 - 50% Physicians
 - 48% Pharmacists
 - Out-of-State students staying and working in Iowa

FY 2017 Appropriations Requests – Maintaining Excellence

- ❖ Operating (\$4.5M for the Core: Teaching Iowa Students)
 - ❖ Recruit and Retain top faculty
 - ❖ Address falling rankings in faculty pay
- ❖ Strategic Initiative (\$1.0M)
 - ❖ Training a 21st Century Iowa Information Technology Workforce (Program benefits UI and Iowa: New jobs/Higher pay)

Meanwhile...

- ❖ Continuing implementation of T.I.E.R. Operations and Classroom Space efficiency programs
 - ❖ Reinvestment in student success
