

**Driving Directions to
Northeast Iowa Community College
Town Clock Center for Professional Development
680 Main Street
Dubuque, IA 52001**

From West:

On US-20 through Dubuque until intersection with US-52 (just before bridge).
Turn left (North) on US-52/3 (Locust St.)
Continue until 5th Street and turn right (East).
1 block and turn left on Main.
Continue to Town Clock. NICC is on East side of plaza.

From East (Illinois):

On US-20 West, from Illinois, cross the bridge.
Turn right (North) on US-52/3 (Locust Street).
Continue until 5th Street and turn right (East).
1 block and turn left on Main.
Continue to Town Clock. NICC is on East side of plaza.

From East (Wisconsin):

On US-61/151 South, from Wisconsin, cross the bridge.
Turn right (West) on W 2nd Street (at light).
Turn right (North) on US-52/3 (Locust Street).
Continue until 5th Street and turn right (East).
1 block and turn left on Main.
Continue to Town Clock. NICC is on East side of plaza.


From North:

On US-52 South into Dubuque (Central Avenue)
Turn right (West) on 5th Street.
Turn right (North) on Main Street.
Continue to Town Clock. NICC is on East side of plaza.


From South:

On US-61/151 North.
Exit at Locust Street (US-52 North).
Continue until 5th Street and turn right (East).
1 block and turn left on Main.
Continue to Town Clock. NICC is on East side of plaza.

A. Iowa Street (Directly behind NICC building): Located on the blocks of Sixth, Eighth and Iowa streets, entrances on Seventh and Eighth streets. Hourly rates:

B. Locust Street: Surrounded by Eighth, Ninth, Bluff and Locust streets, entrances on Bluff and Locust. Hourly rates:

C. Third Street: Located on Iowa Street between Third and Fourth streets. Entrances on Fourth and Third streets. Mix of daily and monthly non-assigned parking.

Metered street parking

On-street parking is available for a fee. Parking meters around the downtown area are color coded to indicate the time limits and the hourly cost of parking: Silver: 10-hour meters; Green: Four-hour meters; Red: Two-hour parking; Blue: One-hour parking; Yellow: 20-minute meters.
