

REPORT OF THE CAPITOL SPACE ALLOCATION COMMITTEE
OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

The Capitol Space Allocation Committee of the Legislative Council held its first meeting on Wednesday, July 16, 1986, in Committee Room 22 of the State House. The Committee discussed the need for additional space for the General Assembly, particularly the need for additional meeting rooms for the standing committees. The Committee toured the areas of the State House presently occupied by the Auditor of State, the Treasurer of State, the Secretary of State and the Department of Management. The Committee scheduled its next meeting for Thursday, July 24, 1986 to meet with the Director of the Department of General Services to discuss space availability in the Capitol Complex and future plans for use of this space and to meet with the affected Constitutional Officers.
