

REPORT OF THE
COMPUTER OUTREACH COMMITTEE
OF THE
LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

June 18, 1986

The Computer Outreach Committee of the Legislative Council met on June 18, 1986, to review the results of the 1986 public access services to the legislative computer, discuss the costs of legislator access to the computer system, and consider enhancements and cost of the 1987 public access services. The Committee makes the following recommendations:

1. That the Legislative Council authorize the Computer Support Bureau to establish a program for legislator access to the legislative computer system and to purchase necessary equipment for the legislator access program. A copy of the estimated costs of establishing the legislator access program is attached to and by this reference made a part of this report.
2. That the Legislative Council set the following fees for not to exceed fifty public access users of the legislative computer system for the 1987 calendar year:
 - a. Basic service only - \$600 annually
 - b. Basic service with extended services including Code search, Code retrieval and Code index search - \$1000 annually
 - c. Extended services only - \$600 annually
