

REPORT OF THE SERVICE COMMITTEE

TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

June 23, 1987

The Service Committee of the Iowa Legislative Council met on June 23, 1987, and makes the following report for approval of the Legislative Council:

1. The Service Committee received and filed annual salary reports from the Computer Support Bureau, the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, and the Legislative Service Bureau (including the Iowa Code Office). The reports include notification of merit step review dates. (The Legislative Council approved the annual salary report of the Office of Citizens' Aide on June 3, 1987.)

2. The Service Committee recommends that the Legislative Council approve an internal restructuring of the Legislative Fiscal Bureau as proposed by the Director. The Director will bring specific proposals for job descriptions, grades, and position reclassifications to the Service Committee and Legislative Council at a future meeting.

3. The Service Committee recommends that the Legislative Council approve the restoration of the one-step reduction incurred by employees of the central legislative agencies who received increases in pay grades as a result of the adoption by the Legislative Council of the Report of the Comparable Worth Study Committee effective with the pay period beginning June 26, 1987. This restoration applies only to legislative employees who actually incurred a one-step reduction. The increase corresponds to the restoration of the step given to executive branch employees in Senate File 504.

4. The Service Committee has scheduled a meeting with the Director of the Department of General Services to discuss the telephone system of the General Assembly.
