CHARGE AND MEMBERSHIP

CHARGE: Review animal agriculture in Iowa, and its impact upon the environment and non-agricultural uses of land and make recommendations to the Legislature by December 16, 1994. The Committee may, within the allowed meeting days, hold public hearings throughout the State.

5 Senate -5 House - 4 Public members.

The 4 public members shall include: an independent pork producer actively engaged in farming; an independent cattle producer actively engaged in farming; an independent poultry producer actively engaged in farming; a representative of an Iowa environmental organization. The House and Senate Majority Leaders and the House and Senate Minority Leaders shall each appoint one public member.
