## REPORT OF THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL COMMITTEE TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

December 5 & 6, 1988

The Legislative Fiscal Committee met on December 5 and 6, 1988, in the State Capitol Building.

The following items were discussed by the Committee:

- 1. General Services Data Processing Capacity
- 2. Department of Human Services Response Time on Legislative Requests
- 3. Collections Services Center Status of transition to Clerk of District Courts
- 4. Update on \$1.0M Appropriation to Department of Revenue and Finance

The Fiscal Committee recommended that the Department of Management eliminate all notations concerning Comparable Worth Pay Adjustments in all budgeting documents. All amounts shall be combined into the salaries line item and should not be "line itemed" or requested separately.
