HOUSE FILE 411

AN ACT

PROVIDING RESIDENT LICENSE FEES FOR HUNTING, FISHING,
TRAPPING, AND RELATED ACTIVITIES TO CERTAIN PERSONS IN THE
ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 483A.1A, subsection 7, paragraph d,
Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:


d. Is a member of the armed forces of the United States
who is serving on active duty, claims residency in this state,
and has filed a state individual income tax return as a

resident pursuant to chapter 422, division II, for the preceding tax year, or is stationed in this state.
