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             The secretary department shall not issue a commercial
  1 24 applicator's license as required in section 206.6 until the 1 25 applicant has furnished evidence of financial responsibility
  1 26 with the secretary consisting either of department. The

                          financial responsibility shall consist of a surety
  1 28 bond, or a liability insurance policy, or an irrevocable 1 29 letter of credit issued by a financial institution. The
     30 department may accept a certification thereof of the evidence
     31 of financial responsibility. Such surety bond or liability
         insurance policy The evidence of financial responsibility
  1 33 shall provide coverage to pay on behalf of the insured all 1 34 sums which the insured shall become amount that the
     35 beneficiary is legally obligated to pay as damages as a result
  2 1 of caused by the pesticide operations of the applicant.
      2 However, the surety bond or liability insurance policy will
     3 evidence of financial responsibility does not apply to damages 4 or an injury which are either is expected or intended from the 5 standpoint of the insured beneficiary. Any such A liability

         submitted as evidence of financial responsibility need not
  2 10 apply to damages or injury to agricultural crops, plants, or
  2 11 land being worked upon by the applicant.
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             The amount of the surety bond or liability insurance
  2 13 evidence of financial responsibility as provided for in this 2 14 section shall be not less than fifty thousand dollars for 2 15 property damage and public liability insurance, each
  2 16 separately. Such surety bond or liability insurance The 2 17 evidence of financial responsibility shall be maintained at
  2 18 not less than that sum amount at all times during the licensed
  2 19 period. The secretary department shall be notified ten days 2 20 prior to any reduction in the surety bond or liability
     21 insurance made at the request of the applicant or cancellation
  2 22 of such the surety bond by the surety or the liability
  2 23 insurance by the <del>surety or</del> insurer. <u>The department shall be</u> 2 24 notified ninety days prior to any reduction of the amount of
  2 25 the irrevocable letter of credit at the request of the
2 26 applicant or the cancellation of the irrevocable letter of
2 27 credit by the financial institution. The total and aggregate
2 28 liability of the surety, and insurer, or financial institution
2 29 for all claims shall be limited to the face of the surety
   2 30 bond, or liability insurance policy, or irrevocable letter of
        <u>credit</u>.
             Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
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  2 33 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
