The operator of a motor vehicle approaching a 1 13 stationary towing or recovery vehicle, a stationary utility 14 maintenance vehicle, a stationary municipal maintenance 1 15 vehicle, or a stationary highway maintenance vehicle, that is 1 16 displaying flashing yellow, amber, or red lights, shall 1 17 approach the vehicle with due caution and shall proceed in one 1 18 of the following manners, absent any other direction by a 1 19 peace officer: 1 20 a. Make a lane change into a lane not adjacent to the 1 21 towing, recovery, utility maintenance, municipal maintenance, 1 22 or highway maintenance vehicle if possible in the existing 1 23 safety and traffic conditions. b.
