The proceeds from the fee shall be used 2 2 11 exclusively for the trout program designated by the 2 12 commission. The commission may grant a permit to a community 2 13 event in which trout will be stocked in water which is not 2 14 designated trout water and a person may catch and possess 2 15 trout during the period and from the water covered by the 16 permit without having paid the trout fishing fee. 17 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICABILITY DATES.
